Dear Parents,

We are thankful that you have chosen Hunting Park Christian Academy for your child! Attached is the re-registration form for the 2021-2022 school year. We have also included a parent survey, a general permission form, an emergency contact update form, a fee schedule, a re-registration checklist, and our chaperone policy. **If you would like to reserve a spot for your child for next school year, please return the attached re-registration form along with payment no later than Friday, February 19th.** If you would like to enroll new siblings, please contact the office to be put on the waiting list. If you do not turn in the form and payment, **you will not be guaranteed a spot for the 2021-2022 school year.** Spots also cannot be guaranteed for students who do not pass. Registration fees are nonrefundable.

Registration Fees:

For the eighth straight year, we are keeping these fees the same! **The fee for registration is \$150 per family; book/RenWeb fees are \$65 per student. Both fees must be paid together, and fees are due with the re-registration form by Friday, February 19th.** *Please remember that all tuition must be current before fees can be applied and a spot saved for your child(ren).*

Tuition:

We are **not** changing the tuition structure or amounts for 2021-2022! (Although, your scholarship amount may change, if your income has changed). The 2021-2022 yearly tuition will be \$5,165 per child. As with the current school year, **once all household proof of income is submitted** (Due May 14th), a grant will be given to each family that will **lower a family's portion to \$2,400 for the first child, \$1,600 for the second, and \$1,100 for each additional child.** This is the third consecutive year with the same family portion. If no proof of income is submitted, parents will be responsible for the entirety of the tuition amount.

Scholarship:

If you plan to apply to HPCA for scholarship, we ask that you first apply to Children's Scholarship Fund. This is a lottery-based scholarship that awards scholarships over a four-year period. Many HPCA families have received awards over the past 11 years. You can apply online at <https://www.csphiladelphia.org/scholarships/apply/>. There are only a few requirements, and the application is short, **but you must apply by March 1st.** If you need assistance, please contact Mr. Deane.

Initial Grant: When proof of income is submitted (**Due May 14th**), a grant is given to the family, which drops the amount parents owe toward tuition to the following amounts:

1st Child ----- \$2,400 / year
2nd Child ----- \$1,600 / year
Additional Siblings -- \$1,100/ year

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Parent Volunteers and Chaperones

Dear Parents,

Due to changes in the law, we are now required to have any parent responsible for a group of children on a field trip to get criminal and child abuse clearances. Our official policy is below. After handing the clearances in the office, we will keep them in your child's folder so it will not be required again for five years. Please go on the websites below to receive your criminal and child abuse clearances before chaperoning a field trip. We will also no longer be able to allow last minute changes in chaperones.

Clearance policy for all volunteers with direct contact of students:

According to the state laws enacted for August of 2015, parent chaperones are now required to get clearances before being allowed to chaperone a field trip. These clearances are good for 5 years. If a parent has resided in Pennsylvania for 10 consecutive years, only the criminal and child abuse clearances are required and they are free. If a parent lived in a different state during that time, an FBI Clearance with finger prints is required and will cost \$27. Parents who would like to chaperone trips can apply for the certifications in the office or at home.
