

# Covid Procedures

## Prevention

**Students must stay home if:**

- 1. They have been exposed to someone with Covid.**
- 2. They are sick**
- 3. They have traveled outside of the state**

**They should stay home for 14 days or until they have a negative Covid test.**

Masks are required in the building, but in class, at the desk, students may opt to wear the face shield.

Students' temperatures will be checked upon entry.

Students are seated 3 feet apart.

# Quarantine Procedures

- ⇒ If a child is exposed to someone with Covid 19 or has traveled outside of the state and does not have symptoms that child should stay home for 14 days or until he/she has a negative Covid 19 test.
- ⇒ If a child has symptoms they should stay home for 10 days from the initial symptoms. The child may return after the 10 days only if he/she has been fever-free without medication for 24 hours.
- ⇒ If a child is in quarantine, he/she should seek to do the assignments on-line or make up the work when feeling better. There will be no option for Zoom learning in this case.
- ⇒ If a child/teacher tests positive for Covid and exposed the other children, the whole class will quarantine for 14 days from the contact. The class will be using Zoom in this case to receive instruction.
