HPCA Kindergarten Supply List 2020-2021

Dear Parents, we will need the following items:

- 1 pack of pencils
- 1 pack of pencil cap erasers
- 2 packs of crayons (one pack is for homework)
- 1 pack of washable markers
- 3 glue sticks
- 2 (5-inch) blunt-tip kid safety scissors (one is for homework)
- 1 pack of dry-erase markers
- 1 small bottle of white glue (for homework)
- 1 durable folder (for homework, labeled with first and last name)
- 2 or 3 boxes of tissue
- 2 bottles of hand soap
- 2 rolls of paper towels

Optional:

- 1 or more bottles of hand sanitizer
