HPCA Kindergarten Supply List 2024-2025

Dear Parents, we will need the following items:

- 1 pack of pencils
- 1 pencil case box
- 1 pack of pencil cap erasers
- 2 packs of crayons (one pack is to keep at home for homework)
- 1 pack of washable markers
- 3 Glue sticks
