HPCA Pre-K 2025 School Supply List

The following is a list of supplies that your pre-k student will need for the upcoming school year. The school will supply pencils, crayons, scissors and erasers. Supplies under school supplies will be kept in the classroom. The home set of materials is for homework and is very important so your child can complete their assignments. ***Lack of supplies is not an excuse for incomplete homework.*** Please replace these as necessary.

Because students have separate materials for home and school, they will not need to bring anything with them daily. All the homework for the week will be taken home in their plastic folder Monday and returned back to school Friday.

Please have the following home and school materials ready for the first day of school.

Materials Needed:

School Set

- 2 Glue Sticks
- 1 Bottle of White Glue
- 1 Plastic Folder for Homework
- 3 Boxes of Tissues
- 1 Bottle of Hand Sanitizer
- 1 Package of Baby Wipes
- 1 Bottle of hand soap
- 1 Box of Ziploc Bags (Gallon-Size)
- 1 Old T-Shirt (Oversized) or Smock for Painting
- 1 Plastic Pencil Box
- 2 Rolls of Paper Towels (to be given to the teacher for classroom use)
- 1 Complete change of clothes in ziploc (to be kept in classroom)
- 1 Reusable water bottle

OPTIONAL:

- 1 or more Containers of Disinfectant Wipes
