DID YOU KNOW?

- The tuition at HPCA is \$7,385 per year, but no parent pays that! The average amount per child is \$1,275!
- 100% of our families receive a grant-in-aid that lowers payments to \$2,400 for the first child, \$1,600 for the second, and \$1,100 for every other child in the family.
- In addition to the above discounts, we offer hardship scholarship for families who need extra help and income-based scholarship to help our lower-income families.
- Parent payments only cover 25% of HPCA's total operating costs!
- This year, we need to raise \$850,000 to keep HPCA affordable. We would love to have your support!

The program is coordinated by Randy Caro, our dean of students (and an alumnus). We also added four new staff members to run the group (including two more alumni who wanted to reinvest in HPCA). We currently have five students in before-school and about thirty students in after-school.



Students start out with a snack and playtime in the gym. After, it is time for homework help and other enriching activities (music, STEM, art) to extend the kids' learning opportunities. Parents have loved being able to focus on family time when their child comes home, since homework is usually finished.



We love being able to support our families with a quality, loving environment outside of school hours. We thank God for providing the resources to make this happen!
