We are excited to welcome Lauren Kim as our 5th grade teacher! She graduated from Loyola University Maryland with a degree in Elementary Education. Here is a brief interview to help you get to know her!

Why did you feel drawn to teach at HPCA?

I really love and believe in the vision of HPCA - R.I.S.E. (*Respond. Ignite. Serve. Excel*). We are trying to equip these children to go into the world, not just to be good citizens, but to be sharers of the Gospel and to live that out.
